### Classroom Procedures

- Students are to be prepared for class upon entering the classroom. This means that they must have their text book( s), folders, pencils, **red** correcting pen, assignments and agenda book with them at the start of class.
- Students are to have pencils sharpened **before** class begins.
- Students are to have assignments labeled properly and stapled **before** class begins.
- Students are to have assignments **out on their desk at the beginning** of the hour to be checked or collected.
- Students are to pay attention, take notes and copy board work and examples from class.
- Students are to record their homework in their agenda book before the end of class.
- Students are to keep all completed and returned assignments for a particular chapter or unit in their social studies binder. It will be helpful to have material in one place to study for quizzes and tests.
- Assignments should be completed in pencil or black or blue ink.
- **Work should be completed neatly and with the student's best effort.**
- It is important that students finish their work in and out of class. They are expected to turn in all work ...on time! Student progress will be assessed on a his/her: homework and class work, direct observation, projects, quiz scores and test/assessment scores.



#### **Come to class prepared!**

Bring a pencil, pen, red pen, agenda book, paper and folder.

### Power Parent

Please sign up in the front office to receive a password and directions on how to use Power Schools to stay informed about your child's assignments and grades. This is the **easiest** way to see if students are turning in work and doing well.

### Social Studies

Students will not have a textbook of their own in 6th grade. Instead, they will receive an online username and password. This will allow students access to the online textbook Western World that we use to support class instruction. A student's best resource for success in social studies is to be attentive in class, take good notes and **KEEP** all papers, notes, etc. for each unit of study organized in a binder.

**Remind101** is a one-way text messaging and email system. With Remind 101 all personal information remains completely confidential.
